

EfficienSea2 Announces Final Conference

On 5-6 April 2018 the 32 partners behind the EfficienSea2 project will showcase their results at a conference taking place in Copenhagen.

It is understood that the conference will be a mix between real-life demonstrations, forward-looking ideas and presentations on innovative maritime solutions.

During the two half days, the focus will be on highlighting the 15 new or improved maritime services, the web-based platform BalticWeb for displaying them on tablets or computers, work on the so-called VHF Data Exchange System (VDES) and the centrepiece of the project: The Maritime Connectivity Platform (MCP) – formerly known as the Maritime Cloud.

Christopher Saarnak, Project Leader of EfficienSea2, explains: *‘We are proud of everything we have achieved during the last three years and look forward to sharing it with as many stakeholders as possible. Our project has been heavy on development, so the most tangible results will all be materialising in the coming months...’*
