

Dr Yu Jiao
receives the (US) ION Bradford W Parkinson Award

Another presentation made at the ION GNSS+ Conference in September was that of the Bradford W Parkinson Award to Dr Yu Jiao in recognition of her graduate student excellence in Global Navigation Satellite Systems in her thesis, *Low-Latitude Ionospheric Scintillation Signal Simulation, Characterization and Detection on GPS Signals*.

The Bradford W Parkinson Award is granted annually to recognize an outstanding graduate student in the field of Global Navigation Satellite Systems (GNSS), and is presented in honour of Bradford W Parkinson for his leadership in establishing the US Global Positioning System and for his work on behalf of the Satellite Division of The Institute of Navigation.

Any graduate student who is a member of the ION and is completing a degree programme with an emphasis in GNSS technology, applications, or policy is eligible to be considered for this award.
