The objective of this booklet is to provide guidance on the safe use of electronic navigation and associated systems on leisure vessels. Good navigational safety is still dependent on the continuous assessment by the skipper/navigator of all the navigation-related information available on the vessel – and not just over-concentrating on some, however beguiling they may be.

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
