

U.S. PNT Advisory Board Meeting 3 – 4 May 2023

Summary for IAIN

The U.S. President’s National Space-based Positioning, Navigation, and Timing Advisory Board met on the third and fourth of May in Annapolis, Maryland.

The board heard a variety of presentations on relevant topics of interest.

Discussions about recommendations and white papers to be submitted to the government were primarily on the second day during the “Roundtable” agenda item.

The board made three recommendations to government:

- **EXCOM provide feedback on our recommendations within 90 days.**
- **Commit to prompt Removal (w/in one day) of significant interference to GPS reception.**
- **Acknowledge importance of PNT & establish a resilient architecture at home and abroad.**
