

**REPORT TO IAIN ON THE ACTIVITIES OF THE U.S. PRESIDENT’S
SPACE-BASED POSITIONING, NAVIGATION, AND TIMING ADVISORY BOARD**

The advisory board met in public sessions twice in 2024.

The first meeting was in Colorado Springs, CO on the 24th and 25th of April.
